Situation The Wilmer Eye Institute at Johns Hopkins, founded in 1925, is internationally-renowned for its expertise in the diagnosis and management of complex medical and surgical eye disease. It is not only the preeminent provider of routine eye care and refractive, optical, cosmetic, and eye trauma services for the Mid-Atlantic region, it is the largest department of ophthalmology in the United States. The Wilmer sites at the Johns Hopkins Hospital and ten other locations in surrounding counties combined the world-class care of Wilmer ophthalmologists and optometrists with the ease and convenience of accessible and efficient outpatient facilities.

At the end of 2012, the Wilmer team tasked Channel Communications with developing a communications plan to support the opening of a new Wilmer Eye Institute location in Bethesda, Maryland along with announcing the complete renovation of an existing facility in Odenton.

Solution The two sites posed distinctly different problems. The clinic in Odenton had been in place for years and was suffering from growing pains. The challenge was to alter current impressions that the facility was cramped and out of date. The Bethesda facility would be the first for Wilmer in the Washington D.C. metro area therefore; the baseline for awareness was zero. Creating awareness for a single new location within the context of a large, media intensive market would be a formidable assignment.


The Odenton program relied on a combination of local newspapers that covered community news supplemented by direct mail directed to existing customers and prospects in the local geography. In Bethesda, broadcast media was employed to build awareness. Ten and fifteen second radio spots on D.C. news stations and transit shelter posters in the vicinity of the new Wilmer facility announced the presence of something new to the heavy commuter traffic in and through Bethesda. Color ads in two local D.C. metro magazines supported the broader effort.

Results Odenton's traffic increased and the opening of the Bethesda center met all of the expectations of the Hopkins/Wilmer staff. Wilmer leadership came back to Channel later in 2013 to announce to the Odenton community that the staff at the Odenton facility was being expanded.




